GENERAL ORDER NO. 2022-12


In accordance with the guidance provided by the Administrative Office of the United States Courts in a memorandum dated February 17, 2021, courts were advised that the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) would discontinue accepting paper records at its Federal Records Center (FRC) facilities beginning in January 2023. As a result, the permanent records listed below, currently housed in Omaha, are eligible for direct transfer to NARA pursuant to the *Guide to Judiciary Policy*, Vol. 10, Ch. 6, Appx. 6B: Records Disposition Schedule 2:

(1) Omaha docket and judgment books.

The Archivist of the United States has approved the deposit of the above records at the Lenexa Federal Records Center in Lenexa, Kansas.
