In accordance with the guidance provided by the Administrative Office of the United States Courts in a memorandum dated February 17, 2021, courts were advised that the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) would discontinue accepting paper records at its Federal Records Center (FRC) facilities beginning in January 2023. (1) Omaha docket and judgment books.
